The conference will take place at the Lower Bavarian Archaeological Museum in Landau a. d. Isar from 20.-23.07.2017 („Kastenhof“: <http://www.kastenhof.landau-isar.de>), our co-operation partner and “jubilee host”.

Possible issues could be boat building tools or fishing gear (fishhooks with or without barbs, harpoons, etc. ...), but also more general questions, e.g. crossing the water or the use of wetland landscapes. There are no chronological restrictions.

Regional topics will also be presented, and we're planning to have guided tours through museum and town as well as a field trip.
